## **The Religion of Today: Modern Therapeutic Deism**

### **The Truth of Today from Colossians 1:15-18**

<sup>15</sup> He...

*"He" is Jesus.*

...is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

*Jesus is God.*

*Jesus is the image of God.*

<sup>16</sup> For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.

*Jesus is the Creator of the world.*

<sup>17</sup> He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

*Jesus is the sustainer of the universe and my universe.*

<sup>18</sup> And he is the head of the body, the church;

*Jesus is my pastor and I am His minister.*

...he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead,

*Jesus is alive.*

...so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

*When Jesus is supreme in my life, my life matters.*
