

Part 2: Tough Love Pastor Grant Fishbook October 16 & 17, 2010

Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples: ² "The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. ³ So you must obey them and do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practice what they preach." – *Matthew 23:1-3*

The Big Issue: <u>Hypocrisy</u>

Cringe Moments with the Pharisees (Matthew 23:13-35)

¹³ "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the kingdom of heaven in men's faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to.

¹⁵ "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You travel over land and sea to win a single convert, and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as you are.

The Issue: Legalism says <u>religious rules</u> are the way to God.

Jesus says: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." – *John 14:6*

²³ "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former. ²⁴ You blind guides! You strain out a gnat but swallow a camel.

The Issue: Hypocrisy creates self-determined <u>loopholes</u>

Jesus wants: Disciples who do the right thing for the right reason

²⁵ "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. ²⁶ Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean.

²⁷ "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of dead men's bones and everything unclean. ²⁸ In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness.

The Issue: Religion is consumed with <u>image</u> management.

Jesus says: Authentic transformation doesn't soak in. It spills out.

God says: "The LORD does not look at the things man looks at. Man

looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the

heart. –1 Samuel 16b
